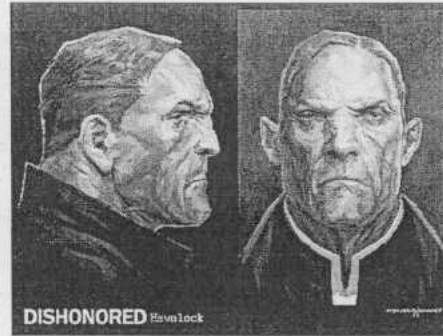


Name: Havelock
